

## GENERAL INFORMATION

The Pendleton Parks and Recreation Department will provide a ski transportation program to Anthony Lakes Ski Resort on Saturdays in January. The City of Pendleton provides the bus as a community service. Fees cover the cost of renting buses exclusively. Participants register for a package of 4 trips. (Passes are transferable)

## DATES AND FEE

January 4, 11, 18, 25

Fee: \$100

## DEADLINE

We can accommodate 40 passengers. First come, first served. We must have 25 bus pass holders by Thursday, December 27th to run the program.

## LESSONS, LIFTS & EQUIPMENT

Lift tickets are \$16 for youth and adults and the bus supervisor will collect lift ticket money on the bus. This compares to regular prices of \$29 for youth and \$35 for adults. ***Please send your child with correct change.*** Participants wanting to take advantage of the \$16 equipment rental need to tell the chaperone so a voucher can be secured at the rental office. Ski equipment may be brought onto the bus.

## ELIGIBILITY

Priority will be given to youth in grades 6-12.

Adults may ride the bus if there is room.

## CANCELLATIONS

Call 966-0228 the morning of the scheduled trip in case of bad weather or lack of snow. Trips will be made up following the end of the regular season or on a "no school" day.

## DEPARTURE & RETURN TIMES

Departure: 6:30 am SHARP!

Return: 7:00 pm approximately

The Recreation Center (McCune Gym, SW 6th & Dorion) is the departure and return point. Lifts close at 4 pm and the bus will leave the resort by 4:30 pm.

## INSURANCE & INJURIES

Insurance provisions for ski injuries are not included. If a participant is injured, parents will be contacted and they must make arrangements for care. If a serious injury occurs, an emergency vehicle will be called and the patient will be transported to the nearest hospital at the patient's expense.

## REGISTRATION

Bus passes may be transferred, but youth must have a signed permission slip before they will be allowed on the bus. If you purchase a pass and wish to transfer it to another person, that person must present the pass and a signed permission slip. Application forms will be available each morning from the bus supervisor.

## ONE DAY ONLY ??

We have a one-day pass option provided we get enough 4-day pass registrations to run the bus. Avoid stand-by and pre-pay for any Saturday trip of your choosing for \$30 per trip with all of the same benefits of a 4-day pass holder.
