I hereby affirm that I am authorized to enter this agreement on behalf of the group, organization, or individual listed below (as used below, "I" refers to such organization or individual).

I agree that at any time I find that use of the facility to be unsafe I will immediately notify the Pendleton Police Department.

I agree that use of the premises, including use of alcohol therein, shall be in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations, and that I take responsibility for said compliance.

Waiver of Liability

I hereby release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the City of Pendleton, its members, officers, employees, agents or any commission thereof, (herein referred to as "City") from all liability for any and all loss or damage, and any claim or demand(s) thereof on account of injury to persons or property or resulting in death arising from the use of City facilities.

Indemnification

I agree to indemnify, save and hold the City, its officers, agents and employees, harmless from any loss, liability, damage or cost that may occur due to the presence of the undersigned in or on the public area described above.

Severability

I acknowledge the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage, and I further expressly agree that the foregoing release, waiver, and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of Oregon in which the consumption of alcoholic liquor upon a public facility occurs and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

Certificate of Liability

If making alcohol available, a Certificate of Liability Insurance is required, listing the City of Pendleton as co-insured with liability limits no less than \$100,000.00.

1. Users can obtain a Certificate of Liability Insurance through one of these ways:
 - a. As a rider on their homeowner's insurance
 - b. As a group rider under the national group's insurance umbrella
 - c. TULIP- Tenant User Liability Insurance Program

OLCC Rules

If making alcohol available, I understand I must comply with all OLCC rules, regulations and all Oregon Laws, including:

- a. If there is no payment or purchase required, and no donations of money are accepted for alcohol, or for entry/admission, or for any other product or service, a liquor license is not needed.
- b. If either requiring payment or purchase, or accepting donations of money, for alcohol, entry or admission, or any other product or service, then a liquor license from the OLCC is needed.

I have read and voluntarily sign this release, indemnity agreement, and waiver of liability.
