Pendleton Aquatic Center Season Passes

EARLY BIRD SEASON PASS

(before 6/10)

Youth \$58.50

Adult \$67.50

Family \$90 for head of household
\$27 for each additional dependent

REGULAR SEASON PASS

(after 6/10)

Youth \$65

Adult \$75

Family \$100 for head of household
\$30 for each additional dependent

*Caregiver Pass (any age) \$30.00

*The "caregiver" pass is for individuals who provide direct supervision to those who by age or condition cannot be in the facility unsupervised. The pass is good only when the holder is providing such direct supervision.

If you live within the city limits of Pendleton and meet defined income limits, you may be eligible for a 50% discount on a pool pass. To apply, pick up an application at the Parks Office or print one from our website and return it with income and family size documentation. Typically, we can approve the application within 24 hours. There is no deadline for low income applications.
