- **Fax form or phone office min. 24 hours in advance of anticipated arrival** to request location be flagged; complete items 1, 2 & 3; fee is due on arrival. Existing forms with the same information as above are acceptable.
- All concrete foundations must be at least 6" thick (+/- 1/2") with a concrete apron of at least 6" that extends around the marker.
- Block 13, the west part of 19, 22, 23, 24, 28, 29, 30, 32, 33, 34, 35, and 36 are flat markers only. Blocks 29 and 30 may have a 3" raised setting.
- Cemetery office hours are 7 am to 4 pm, Monday thru Friday; for installations that occur outside office hours, payment can be placed in drop box at office and stone will be inspected in place the next business day.
- Location will be marked with orange fluorescent flags at stone corners and a tall metal marker that will point the direction the stone should face and include an identification tag confirming the name and grave location.
- Soil/sod removed during installation can be placed in the marked waste dirt pile behind the park/cemetery shop.
- Installer will be responsible for correcting non-compliant markers. Olney Cemetery will not assume any risk for markers delivered outside of normal business hours.
